

## Crittenden Estate Peninsula Pinot Gris 2021 The Real Review 92/100

Light straw tint to the glass. Honeydew melon, lemon balm and warm pastry aromas. Medium-bodied, sitting in a deep golden-fruit profile. A textural glide across the palate, hints of spice and dried fig linger amongst it as well. The finish is long with both acidity and phenolics drying the end well. Reviewed March 2022

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
