Light to medium red colour with a strong tinge of purple. The bouquet is bunchy and dried-herby, dried flowers too, with lots of 'forest floor' nuances, while the palate is light to medium-weight and very savoury, with again foresty characters and drying tannins. Elevated acidity shows. A deceptively big-structured pinot, which would suit stronger foods (Feb 2020)
