

## Crittenden Estate 2016 Cri de Coeur Savagnin The Real Review 95/100

Deep golden-yellow colour of an aged white wine. The bouquet is tremendously complex and profound, loaded with flor-sherry like aldehydes and nuttiness, perhaps incorporating some oak. Grilled hazelnuts and buttered toast. The same flavours flow through to the palate, which is very intense and penetrating, rich and generous and long. It's all beautifully harmonised.
