Light straw tint to the glass. Honeydew melon, lemon balm and warm pastry aromas. Medium-bodied, sitting in a deep golden-fruit profile. A textural glide across the palate, hints of spice and dried fig linger amongst it as well. The finish is long with both acidity and phenolics drying the end well.
