Middling ruby-red in colour, this looks bright in the glass. It smells fresh and youthful with floral aromas woven through herbal and foresty notes. It's less about overt fruit than some, but there's a whiff of raspberry about it that's very appealing. Elegance is more the thing here, and the leafy-flavoured, light to middleweight palate reinforces that feel with fine texture, a supple middle, a soft-perfumed finish and tight underlying structure Jan 2021
