A dry, structural release. It's perfumed on the nose and indeed in the mouth but the main impression is one of dry, sturdy control. Macerated cherry flavours are the foundation though woody spice, mint and saltbush characters play roles. There's grunt to the tannin here, in a good way, and it sits neatly in the hand of the fruit.
